2. Eligibility

(1) Books on law and society re Asia published in the calendar year of 2019 are eligible.

(2) In addition to single-authored books, co-authored books are eligible, but collected works (i.e., edited volumes) are not.

(3) Either the nominator or the nominee must be ALSA members. If the nominator is the publisher, then the nominee or, if the book is co-authored, at least one of the nominees (i.e. at least one of the authors) must be an ALSA member.

3. Nominations

(1) Nominations, including self-nominations, must be submitted to all the committee members listed above.

(2) Nominations will be accepted until May 15, 2020.

(3) Nominators are required to ask the publisher of the nominated book to send a review copy to every committee member before May 15, 2020. If the publisher would not send review copies of the books to all the committee members, electronic copies will also be acceptable.

4. Announcement of the Award and Award Ceremony

(1) Up to two Awards and up to two Honorary Mentions will be announced in the second week of July 2020.

(2) The Award Ceremony will be held on the last day of the two-day ALSA Conference (Bangkok, Thailand), which is 19 December 2020. We regret that we are unable to provide any travel grant.

(3) Recipients of the Award and the Honorary Mention will receive free membership in the ALSA for the calendar years of 2021 and 2022.
